He spent his whole life span for the upliftment of the wreakers, downtrodden. He was one of the greatest visionary persons who worked throughout his whole life in movements like Mahad Chawadar Lake Satyagrah, satyagrah of kala Rama temple admission for untouchables to reform the social evils only to retain the unity and integrity of the nation. 'Are these ideals to be found in Indian society? The Indian society does not consist of individuals. Given this fact it is not necessary to argue the point. The existence of the caste system is a standing denial of the existence of those ideals of society and therefore of Democracy'. Dr. Ambedkar as Economist:

He predicted the probable problems and artificial calamities which will have to face to the Indian people in future through in his research works. He also foretold the inflations and declination of Rupees through his dissertation 'The Problems of Rupees its origin and solution in (1923). His opinion in this book was lead to establish reserve Bank of India. The policies of Indian economy had been also impacted by the views of Dr. Ambedkar.

Dr. Ambedkar as Agriculturarist:

He led farmers' movements. He had studied in depth of Indian Agriculture. He had written research Articles, organised seminars and conferences to realise the situation and contemporary problems of the peasant, farmers, none land holder. He expected to get solutions through such organisation. All his relating thoughts mentioned in his article 'Small Holding in Indian and their Remedies' that holdings of lands by few people are acute problem of Indian Agriculture. He reminded various disadvantages. He said that there may raise the problems, like resources, difficulties in cultivation and utilisation, increase in cost, inadequate income, and low productivity, so the affect of deplorable standard of living cause of insufficient income.

As per the views of Dr. Ambedkar agriculture's productivity is related to mainly with the size of holdings of land with some other factors like labour and capital which are bounded in limit. It shows the quantity and quality. A large size of land can become fruitful to increase production if the resources of land, capital and labours are available at adequate in numbers and quantity with its quality. He also predicted forthcoming problems concerning exploitation and slavery. He opined that the caste system and slavery are the factors to create bounded labours those are to be exploited. Eventually the system is an obstacle in economical development. So he fought to abolish such type of caste system throughout his whole life. He suggested some solution for the problems relating to Agriculture.
